

Increase our impact in dance and society (the outcome we're seeking)

The RAD is known worldwide for excellence and joy in dance. Through us, dance is recognised as a vital means to empower people with the physical and mental attributes needed for modern life. Through us, dance is seen as inclusive and adaptable, a means to express our humanity and make real connections in our complex digital world. We have the evidence to show the difference we make, to individuals, to society and to the arts sector. People turn to us above others because of our strong brand, our legacy, and our belief that excellence is achievable for all.

Governments and donors recognise that dance helps people thrive, improves mental health, counters isolation, information overload, and online dependency. This starts with early years, with nurseries across the world using our products, sparking a life-long love of dance and engagement with the RAD.

We are influencing the dance eco-system, changing what and who audiences see on stage. Our connection to the profession is helping us achieve our ambition of having an RAD dancer on every stage.

We are in parts of the world new to us and have grown where we are already established. Our education and learning products are tailored to suit different national, social, and demographic trends.

People hear of us through multiple channels – social media, online, on TV, through virtual reality performances at landmarks across the world. We have traced former RAD participants – our alumni – who, along with celebrities, help spread the word about what we offer.

Elevate dance teacher education

We celebrate being a prestigious arts academy, of distinguished dance artists and educators, promoting and maintaining high standards in dance. This is why we were created over a century ago. Our teacher education programmes are central to what we do. We are the organisation of choice, across the world, for students and professionals who want to teach. People aspire to qualify with us, knowing our programmes of study are of the highest standard and are recognised as the best.

We offer a range of study routes, from training for assistant teachers through to the highest degree levels, and onwards to Continuing Professional Development (CPD). We also offer courses for professionals and vocational students to expand their employment opportunities. Students get unique access to top artists and scholars, tutors and mentors, and the big names in dance, learning with great dance artists, and giving them the skills in turn to help others excel.

Harnessing the latest in teaching practice, dance science, innovation and creative thinking, our students are challenged and enthused. Our education is grounded in artistry and practice, combined with proven learning theory. Students understand our syllabi, are introduced to Benesh and our other products, coming out equipped to teach the 'RAD Way' to the highest standards.

We offer teacher education in ballet, musical theatre, and other dance genres, at all levels, in partnerships worldwide to expand who we can reach and what we can offer – performance and education, dance and health, dance and business, dance and technology, the potential is endless.

Our degrees are provided through licensed university partners around the world, accredited by us to show they meet our high standards of excellence, and student numbers are strong and growing. There is appetite for dance teachers in parts of the world new to us. Our teacher education is recognised by regulators and on quality frameworks everywhere, enhancing their attraction and access to funding. Quality standards remain high – it is our licence to operate that attracts people to us above others. We provide scholarships for research, at Masters and Doctorate levels, which feeds back into our own learning and teaching practice.

Our teaching members value the high quality of relevant and varied CPD – framed as 'Continuing Excellence' – shaped to support and develop them throughout their career as a teacher, building credentials towards higher education qualifications if they wish. We are clear what is core learning, and where they can choose according to their interests and specialisms.

Expand ballet and go beyond

Ballet is still at our core, and we say it with pride, given that it is at the heart of many dance forms. We have extended its reach, through refreshed frameworks and syllabi, through new markets and countries, and through partnerships, in sport, for example,

The content of our syllabi has input from renowned choreographers and other professionals to keep them fresh, modern, and exciting, with excellence and effectiveness as our motivating considerations. We are leaders in safe practice, our syllabi take account of the requirements of vocational schools and programmes, properly preparing students if that is their chosen path.

Participants have a positive exam experience from the outset, inspiring them with the confidence and desire to continue. We support them to prepare for assessments, with exam-readiness products, offered across the world. We recognise and celebrate the parents, guardians, and carers of our participants, whose support is so critical to their child's enjoyment and achievements.

We experiment with virtual reality, augmented reality, Al, and other emerging technologies, to push the boundaries in how we teach, and how people learn, winning innovation awards.

Our IT systems are modern and our processes lean, with a focus on efficiency and productivity. We automate where possible and harness AI to reduce manual work, to give us greater insight from our data, and to enhance our offer to members and others. Modern IT is the pre-requisite for our evolving digital innovation.

Our innovation extends to sustainability. Given our international footprint and need for travel, we focus on environmental sustainability wherever we can, for example in our dance clothing and retail products, our certificates and medals, and energy usage.

Secure financial position

Our dance library and museum, the largest in Europe, brings dance researchers and fans from far and wide.
